What is it? A socio-ethical analysis of a feasibility study for an antibiotic surveillance program in Quebec

Why ethics? A collective process of thinking proposed to strengthen the bridges between health, agriculture and ecology.

What is the problem? How do we connect people to policy, knowledge to decision-makers and data to researchers?

What is proposed? A framing problem! We must lead the way for complex and systemic thinking.

Three nested starting points (person, institution & knowledge) requiring three interdependent thinking processes on the governance of data, change and facts
